From February 15 Regular Council Meeting:

- ◆The Water Meter Reserves Policy No. 44 and The Purchasing Policy No. 46 were approved.
- ♦The date for the Annual Village Wide Garage Sale was set for May 13. In an Economic Development initiative, Council has approved inclusion of a petting zoo, face painting as well as a bouncy castle. There was also discussion of closing off a portion of Hanson Street to allow home based businesses to set up tables as well as Village residents.
- ◆There will be **no March Regular meeting** on Wednesday March 15, 2017.
- ♦ A Special Meeting will be held on March 20, 2017 where ISL Engineering will be discussing options/procedures and 5/10 year planning/budgeting in regards to the water line assessment.




2017 Dog Tag Rates: After Jan 31st:
