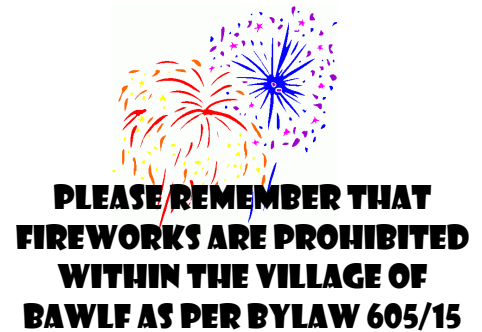

of any kind is permitted.**

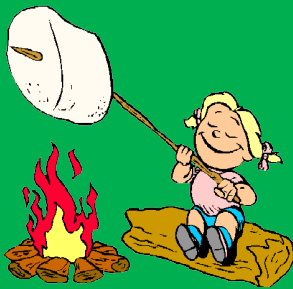
