Land Use Bylaw 623/17—was amended to include private swimming pools Utility Services Bylaw 625/17—The "billing" section was amended to include online payment regulations

Bylaws Read at the June 21st Regular Meeting of Council given First Reading:

Business License Bylaw 620/17—All businesses that are currently in operation in Bawlf will be required to have a business license in place prior to January 1, 2018. After the I third and final reading, the application form will be available at the Village Office and on our website.
