There have been issues with people dumping garbage at the Burn Pile.

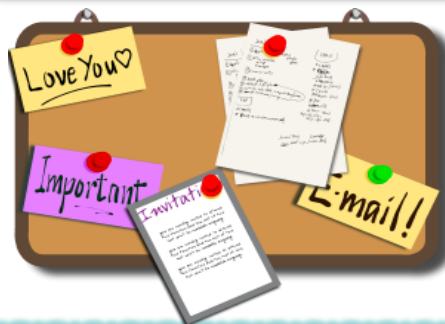
ONLY "dumping" allowed at the burn pile is trees/brush.

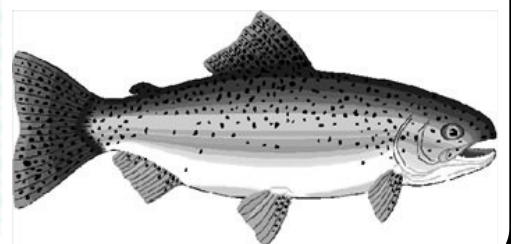


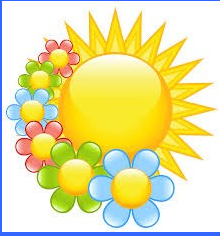

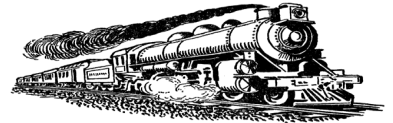
