Some reminders for the residents of Bawlf:

- ◇ Tax Assessments/Notices were sent out in June. **Taxes are due by close of business day on August 31, 2015. Any payments received in the office after this will be subject to penalty**
- ◇ Please ensure that you are maintaining your property in the back alleys; cutting/weed eating tall grass and putting garbage cans away.
- ◇ The Burn Pile will be closed temporarily due to flooding. Please remember that the burn pile is only for tree trimmings and brush—it is not for garbage. Bags of leaves or lawn trimmings must be dumped in the compost area without any bags.
- ◇ Bylaw 549/07 Noise Control Bylaw—violation under Section 3
3.1.4 cause any non-essential noise between 2200hrs of one day and 0700hrs of the next day or between 2200hrs of one day and 1200hrs of the next day if that next day is a holiday.

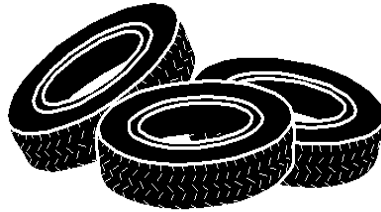
