

BYLAW 563/08

A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF BAWLF IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA FOR THE PURPOSE OF RESTRICTING THE USE OF WATERING LAWNS, INCLUDING THE CONSEQUENCES OF VIOLATING THE RESTRICTIONS.

WHEREAS the Council of the Village of Bawlf in the Province of Alberta deems it necessary to restrict the use of water for the purpose of watering lawns pursuant to the Municipal Government Act 1994 Chapter w6.1 and all amendments thereto.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Village of Bawlf duly assembled **ENACTS** as follows:

1. That the residents of the Village of Bawlf be restricted to watering their lawns between the hours of 7:00 p.m. – 10:00 a.m.
2. That any resident in violation of Section 1 will:
 - a. receive a warning on the first offence;
 - b. be fined \$25.00 on the second offence;
 - c. be fined \$100.00 on the third offence; and
 - d. have their water turned off and be fined \$100.00 for the fourth and all subsequent offences.
3. That the resident's water be turned back on upon payment of the \$100.00 fine plus the reconnection fee as specified in the Master Rates Bylaw.
4. That this bylaw is enforceable by the Bylaw Enforcement Officer, the Village Manager or his/her designate.
5. That Bylaw 524/04 is hereby repealed.
6. That this bylaw comes into force and effect on the day of final passing thereof.

Read a First time this 24th day of June, 2008;

Read a Second time this 15th day of July, 2008;

Read a Third time and finally passed this 15th day of July, 2008.
