On January 31, 2018, the Minister of Municipal Affairs received a petition requesting that a viability review of the Village of Bawlf be initiated.

The *Municipal Government Act* requires that a person be designated to carry out the duties of a chief administrative officer for the purpose of determining the sufficiency of the petition. I have attached a copy of Ministerial Order No. MSL:013/18 appointing Roy Bedford of Municipal Affairs as the person designated for this purpose. Mr. Bedford has 45 days from the date the petition was received to report to the Minister of Municipal Affairs on the sufficiency of the petition.


MINISTERIAL ORDER NO. MSL:013/18
